Reservation Deposit

\$1500 reservation deposit due Dec. 1, 2011. Final payment due Jul. 1, 2012.

Cancellations

Up to 60 days prior, forfeit deposit

59-31 days prior, 50% of trip cost

30 days prior, 100% trip cost

(Cancellations within the 30 days are submitted to operators and hotels. Refunds are at their discretion.)

Insurance

Medical, evacuation, and repatriation insurance is required. Cancellation and interruption is strongly recommended. Waivers for pre-existing conditions usually require you purchase your policy soon after submitting your reservation deposit.

Flights

Baggage on local air and road transfers is limited to 20kg (44lbs) per person in total, i.e. including camera equipment and carry-on bags. All luggage must be soft bags, no frames or wheels.

Medical

We are in a malaria area. Other immunizations are recommended. Tanzania lies within the yellow fever region of Africa. All visitors are required to have proof of vaccination at least ten days prior to travel.

Passports/Visas

A passport and visa are required for travel to Tanzania. Your passport should be valid for six months prior to entry with at least two consecutive blank pages, not including amendment and endorsement pages. The current tourist visa fee is \$100, valid for one year. Passports should be valid for a minimum of six months beyond the date the visa is obtained.
